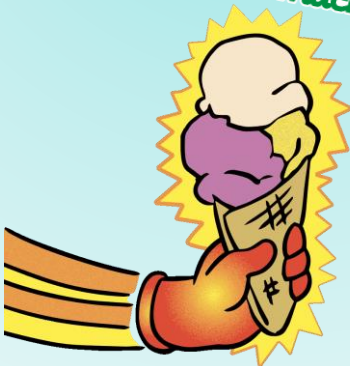
Local Lunch Buddies
